## City of Erie 2012 Property Taxes

Erie, PA (January 17, 2012) — City Treasurer Susan E. DiVecchio, would like to notify City of Erie Taxpayers, that 2012 property tax bills have been mailed. If a property owner does not receive their tax bill by the end of January, please contact the City of Erie Treasurer's office at 870-1210. The office is open weekdays from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Information is printed on the front and back of the 2012 tax bills. Property owners are asked to please review each bill thoroughly.

The school tax bill reflects the homestead exclusion which has been provided under the Pennsylvania Taxpayer Relief Act. If your taxes are escrowed, property owners should mail the tax bills to their mortgage company.

Taxes can be paid online with a VISA or MASTERCARD through the City of Erie's website [www.erie.pa.us](http://www.erie.pa.us) or in person at 626 State Street, Room 105. There is a 3% convenience fee added to all bills paid by credit card.
